## **Middle Level Student Council Advisor of the Year** **A call for nominations**

The Nevada Association of Student Councils (NASC) recognizes that middle level advisors are instrumental to the success of each school's Student Leadership Program and the continued development of student council in Nevada. For this reason, NASC will recognize an outstanding middle level advisor at the State Conference this spring. All schools that include grades 7 and 8 in Nevada are invited to nominate an outstanding student council advisor for the Nevada Middle Level Advisor of the Year. The state winner will represent Nevada in the National Middle Level Advisor of the Year selection process.

Nominees for Middle Level Advisor of the Year must have two full years of experience as a student council advisor in Nevada and be from a school that attends the middle level conference in his/her area. Additionally, advisors who have previously won the Nevada Middle Level Advisor of the Year Award must wait three years before being nominated again.

To nominate the advisor from your school, submit a letter of recommendation from a licensed administrator and have a MS/JHS student complete the enclosed nomination form. Letters should highlight the advisor's experience, organizational skills, school spirit and role as a motivator/inspiration.

The National Advisor of the Year criteria will be considered when selecting the state winner so you may want to address these items in your comments:

- ◆ Activities on Campus (ie - dances, teacher appreciation etc.)
- ◆ Council Service Projects (ie - raising money for charity, volunteering)
- ◆ Local/State Student Council Involvement (ie - attending conferences & meetings)
- ◆ Recognition and Awards (council & individual) / National Student Council involvement (ie LEAD conference)

The admin letter must be one page only (single sided), typed in 10 pt font (or larger) and postmarked by **March 1st, 2010**.
